



Q. What work does Homescop do and what jobs are available?

Q. Will I be able to work in my home town?

A. Currently our semi-independent houses are in Southport and Aintree. The residential children's homes are in Liverpool, with a third one planned potentially in the St Helens area, so the work will be where staff are required. We try to be flexible, but as a small business, we must consider the staffing needs at our various establishments first. We also require staff to cover for each other at times but try to keep out staff teams stable.
